

COED PARTNER STUNT COMPETITION GUIDELINES

1. Participants must be official members of the school and/or program they are representing and meet eligibility requirements for age in their respective division.
2. The routine should be performed to all music. Both participants must begin with both feet on the ground. Length of routine can be no longer one-minute. The following penalties will apply for the routine going over the time limit:
 - 1 - 5 seconds over time will result in a .5 deduction
 - 6 or more seconds over time will result in a 1.0 deduction
3. Timing begins with the first movement, voice, or note of music, whichever comes first.
4. Each team is required to have an adult remain at the music station to start and stop music and to assure the music is on correct track.
6. Each participating couple **MUST** provide a spotter. Only one spotter may be on the mat as needed to make the stunt legal. Spotter may not assist with performance. Spotter may not touch or assist any stunts. In the event a spotter touches or assists a stunt a 2.0 deduction will be assessed per occurrence
7. Partner stunt couples should be in their school/program uniform.
8. A participant may take part in only ONE (1) coed partner stunt routine.
